11 Days | 10 Nights Auckland | Rotorua | Christchurch | West Coast | Queenstown | Milford Sound

Day 1 Kia Ora, welcome to Aotearoa

Upon arrival at Auckland Airport, meet your driver in the arrival hall and transfer to your hotel. After checking in, you have the rest of the day free to relax or explore while waiting for the rest of the group to arrive.

Accommodation: Crowne Plaza (or similar) - 1 Night, with breakfast



Day 2
Auckland - Waitomo - Rotorua (B/L/D)

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before departing for Waitomo to visit the renowned Waitomo Glowworm Caves. We'll travel south from Auckland through the scenic Bombay Hills and the lush Waikato region. Upon reaching Waitomo, embark on a guided tour showcasing over 250 meters of stunning underground landscapes.

The highlight is a serene boat ride along the Waitomo River, where thousands of glowworms create a magical light display.



After the tour, enjoy a traditional New Zealand barbecue lunch at Roselands Restaurant.

Next, continue your journey to Rotorua and check into your hotel.

In the evening, dine at a local Indian restaurant.

Accommodation: Distinction Rotorua (or similar) - 2 Nights, with breakfast



Day 3 Rotorua (B/L/D)

Rotorua - Auckland (B/L/D)

Day 5
Auckland / Fly / Christchurch (B/L/D)

After breakfast, transfer to Auckland Domestic Airport for your flight to Christchurch (flight not included). Upon arrival, meet your guide and visit the International Antarctic Centre.



Following this, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant and then take a brief city tour of Christchurch.

Transfer to your hotel and enjoy dinner at a local Indian restaurant.

Accommodation: Distinction Christchurch (or similar) - 1 Night, with breakfast

Day 6
Christchurch - Hokitika - Franz Josef
Glacier (B/L/D)

Start your day with breakfast before traveling by coach along the scenic TranzAlpine Route, offering breathtaking views of New Zealand's rugged West Coast. Arrive in Hokitika for a local lunch before continuing to Franz Josef.

Check into your hotel to freshen up. In the evening, enjoy dinner at a local Indian restaurant.

Franz Josef - Wanaka - Queenstown

Payment Conditions

For Bookings Made More Than 35 Days Before Departure:

- A deposit of NZ\$250 per person is due within 5 working days of receiving the booking confirmation.
- The remaining balance must be paid at least 31 days before departure. After this payment, the final confirmation and itinerary will be provided.
- If the full payment is not made 31 days before departure, the booking may be cancelled.

For Bookings Made Less Than 35 Days Before Departure:

• Full payment is required within 5 working days of receiving the booking confirmation.

Payment Process

Deposit Payment:

• Can be made by credit card (via a link in the confirmation) or by bank transfer

Balance Payment:

• Must be made by bank transfer to the Pacific Destinations bank account (details on the invoice).

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation by Pacific Destinations or Its Suppliers

- 1..1 Pacific Destinations may cancel all or some services in cases such as:
 - 1The Agent/Client fails to make a payment.
 - Situations of force majeure, such as dangerous weather or conditions threatening client safety.
 - The supplier cannot provide the services due to unforeseen circumstances.

2.2 Cancellation Conditions:
